Labor Law – Definition

Section 2. 12. "Place of public assembly" shall include (1) a theatre, (2) moving picture house, (3) assembly halls maintained or leased for pecuniary gain where one hundred or more persons may assemble for amusement, or recreation, except (a) halls owned by churches, religious organizations, granges, and public association and free libraries as defined by section two hundred fifty-three of the education law, and (b) hotels having fifty or more rooms.

Section 870-c.12 "Viewing Stand" means a bleacher, grandstand or similar structure used at carnivals, fairs and amusement parks for public occupation, which has a capacity of one hundred or more persons, and which is of such nature that accidental personal injuries may be incurred in its assembly, disassembly or use.

Section 870-c.15 "Tent" means a tent which has a capacity of three hundred or more persons and which is used at carnivals, fairs and amusement parks.

Instructions

1. Filing Requirements:

Filing of plans and applications is required for tents and viewing stands subject to Section 870 of the Labor Law and for new or altered buildings to be used as places of public assembly except for such places located in the City of New York or in other cities having a bureau of buildings which is charged with the duty of enforcing a building code enacted by the legislative body of such city, or in a city, town, or village which has assumed responsibility under section 472 of the Labor Law.

2. Architect's Seal and Signature:

The seal and signature of a New York Registered Architect or Professional Engineer are required on plans when such plans are subject to examination by the Department.

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
