





The Importance and Uses of BPS Data

- Measures the number and valuation of new housing units authorized by permit
- Key input to three Principal Federal Economic Indicators
 - New Residential Construction
 - New Residential Sales
 - Construction Spending
- Included in Residential Fixed Investment segment of GDP
- Informs local population estimates in-between decennial Census years





Strengths

Leading

- Permit is issued before construction begins
- Component of the Conference Board's U.S. Leading Economic Index

Large

- Requests local governments to self-report so collection costs are low and response rates are high
- Both monthly and annual BPS programs cover all permit-issuing jurisdictions
- Permits are public information not subject to confidentiality restrictions

Local

Detailed local data are available both monthly and annually





BPS Current Methodology

- Voluntary survey of the 20,000 permit-issuing jurisdictions in the U.S.
- Cutoff sample of jurisdictions surveyed monthly
 - Target collection to places that issue 6 or more permits annually based on previous three years
 - These 8,400 places account for roughly 99% of all units authorized
 - Rely on modeling for remaining low-activity places
- All places not collected monthly are surveyed annually
- Place level estimates are summed to create all higher-level aggregates





BPS Current Collection Strategy

Monthly Collection

- Vast majority of response is collected via online reporting
- Places in monthly collection receive either an email or mailed notice that online collection has opened for the next month
- Email reminder to encourage response before preliminary data is finalized

Annual Collection

- Initial contact via mailed notice that online reporting is open for annual data
- Follow up attempts made via mailed paper form, email, and telephone follow-up





Data Products

- Measures
 - number and valuation of permitted housing units
- Granularity
 - Monthly, year-to-date, and annual
 - U.S., Region, Division, MSA, State, County, Jurisdiction
 - Total, 1-unit, 2-unit, 3/4-unit, 5+ units
- Available on-line https://www.census.gov/construction/bps/
 - Excel
 - ASCII
 - Tableau Visualization
 - Complete .CSV file (coming soon)
- Timing
 - Preliminary Monthly 12th workday of following month @ 8:30am
 - Revised Monthly 17th workday of following month @ 8:00am
 - Annual 1st workday in May of following year





BPS: Modernization Efforts

- Redesigning the BPS sample
 - Completed in February 2022
 - Transitioned from probability sample to cutoff sample
 - Target monthly collection to places that issue 6 or more permits annually based on previous three years
 - Now provides complete local estimates on a monthly basis
 - Positions program to maximize use of alternative data sources
 - Jurisdictions not asked to report monthly, still collected annually





BPS: Modernization Efforts

- Continually updated target universe
 - Transition from 2014 target universe to an annually updated universe began with the January 2023 monthly BPS data
 - Jurisdictions found to be issuing permits added each subsequent January data month going forward
 - Eliminates the need for 10 year universe re-designs/overlap periods
 - Provides more current coverage of the permit issuing universe





BPS: Modernization Efforts

- Alternative permit data sources
 - Purchase 3rd party permit data feeds to reduce reliance on traditional collection and voluntary reporting
 - Leveraging data science methods for permit classification and geolocation
 - Initial use of data began in May 2023






BPS: Future Improvements and Research

- Imputation by division instead of region
- Research additional or optimal revision span for monthly data
- More frequent permit-issuance status updates from nonpermit jurisdictions
- Increase use of 3rd party or public use permit files to supplement respondent reported data





BPS: Working with the data

Available Data

Current (2019 - present)

Download our latest U.S., Region, State, and MSA-level data in excel format. Revised permits are usually released on the 17th workday of the month. (See Release Schedule for actual dates.)

Historical (1995 - 2019)

Download historical State and MSA-level data in text format.

ASCII files by State, MSA, County or Place

Download detailed State, MSA, County, or Place level data in comma-delimited text format. (See the documentation folder for instructions on how to convert text files into excel format.)

Annual Tables, Charts, and Graphs

View charts, maps, and graphs from the latest annual release. Annual data are released on the first workday of May for the previous year.

Data Visualizations

Explore building permits data with infographics and visualizations.

Announcements

View current or previous announcements related to the Building Permits Survey. Annual estimates for 2022 were released on May 1, 2023.

BPS: Working with the data

Source code identifying source of data as shown:



- Building Permits C-404 survey form
- Received data in electronic format
- Received residential data via online reporting
- Received residential data from another source equivalent to reported data
- No report received, imputed data
- No report received and no imputed data





BPS: Working with the data

Special procedures:

In addition to survey data received from a respondent, the following additional data sources may be used:

Electronic Files – Permit data may be received directly from the respondent in the form of electronic files. Analysts use the electronic files to determine the values of the required data items each month.

Survey of Construction – Permit data may be received through the Survey of Construction (SOC), which is used to collect information on housing starts, sales and completions. Data from the SOC are available for about 900 places for which Census Bureau field representatives list permits issued for new residential construction as part of the SOC sampling operation. (Please go to the <u>Survey of Construction Methodology</u> for more information.)

Third-Party Data – Permit data may be received through data purchased from Construction Monitor LLC. Third-party permit data are processed to ensure alignment with BPS classifications and standards prior to aggregation and inclusion in estimates.





BPS: Imputation

- Imputation methodology when direct reported or equivalent to reported data not available
 - Imputed units for each structure type (1 unit, 2-4 units, 5+ units) are determined by multiplying a non-reporting place's most recent annual data by a factor
 - The factor is estimated monthly based on the ratio of reported monthly activity to the annual activity (for the same places)

$$factor = \frac{\sum reported\ monthly\ activity}{\sum annual\ activity}$$

• The factor is computed independently in each region for each structure type





BPS: How can you help?

- Our primary goal is accurate, timely, and complete data
 - Encourage local reporting
 - Use place level data to analyze reporting status
 - Reach out to us if you see something concerning/unusual
 - Use of State data files with similar information
