

DIVISION OF IMMIGRANT POLICIES AND AFFAIRS 2012-2022 PROGRAM ACHIEVEMENTS*

OUTREACH



The Division of Immigrant Policies and Affairs (DIPA) has participated in 1,220 outreach events and reached 64,202 individuals.

ANTI-HUMAN TRAFFICKING



The Division of Immigrant Policies and Affairs participated in 206 anti-trafficking task force meetings and participated in investigations of 358 potential victims. A total of 152 requests for U-visas were received and 57 U-visa certifications were issued. A total of 132 requests for T-visas were received, and 55 T-visa certifications were issued.

HOTLINE CALLS



The Division of Immigrant Policies and Affairs received a total of 3,636 calls to its Hotline ranging from questions about the labor law, requesting presentations and to report issues in the workplace.

AGRICULTURE LABOR PROGRAM (AgLP)



Agriculture Labor Program staff met with 113,364 workers. Of that number, 34,263 were identified as MSFWs. There were 8,199 Apparent Violations; of those, 6,832 were resolved informally. The Agriculture Labor Program assisted in the recovery of \$1,054,012 in monies owed to 1,257 workers.

FOREIGN LABOR CERTIFICATION UNIT (FLCU)



The Foreign Labor Certification Unit received and processed 5,032 H-2A orders requesting 72,352 workers and 5,330 H-2B job orders requesting 54,693 workers for New York businesses.
