## In New York State, Domestic Workers:

- Must be paid at least the minimum wage
- Must receive overtime pay at $11 / 2$ times their basic rate of pay:
o After 40 hours of work in a week or
o After 44 hours of work in a week (if they live in the employer's home)
- Have a right to one day of rest in each calendar week, or overtime pay if they agree to work on that day
- Are entitled to at least three paid days off after one year of work for the same employer
If an employer gives a domestic worker meals and/or lodging, the employer may be granted a specific credit toward the minimum wage paid to the worker.
