In September 2024, there were 111,400 private sector jobs and 156,500 nonfarm (private + government) jobs in the region.

Job Gains




The region gained 900 private sector jobs and lost 200 government jobs over the past year.

Regional Industry Mix, September 2024






Unemployment Rate

All of the largest labor force areas in the North Country Region had unemployment rates below the State's unemployment rate in September 2024.




The region's unemployment rate (3.2%) is less than the State's unemployment rate (4.0%) by 0.8 percentage points.





US Census Bureau Diversity Index Scores, 2010 and 2020







Regional Labor Market Developments

Good news

The Empire State Development Corporation has awarded \$20 million to BETA Technologies, a cutting-edge electric aerospace company, to fund a \$41 million expansion at Plattsburgh International Airport (Clinton County). BETA Technologies will work in partnership with Clinton County to invent new electric vertical takeoff and landing aircraft. As part of the facility's expansion agreement, BETA has committed to create 85 full-time jobs.

A new Burlington store, the retailer's 70th in New York State, is scheduled to open in Watertown (Jefferson County) on November 1, 2024. The 30,000-square-foot store will employ between 65 and 75 people.

The Harrisville Family Health Center reopened in Harrisville (Lewis County) in August 2024. The facility's renovation became possible upon approval by the New York State Department of Health. Besides its medical director, the clinic will be staffed by a physician assistant, a licensed practical nurse and a physician office assistant.

Lovers of Indian cuisine in the North Country region can now satisfy their craving at a new Indian restaurant in Lake Placid (Essex County). Heritage Indian Grill opened for business in September 2024 and is the first Indian restaurant to open in the Tri-Lakes region in many years. The large menu offers many classic Indian recipes and some mild dishes for those whose taste buds aren't strong enough for intense spices.

Bad news

After 25 years in business, Timeless Frames, a frame manufacturer from Watertown (Jefferson County), is set to shut its doors. The company had to lay off 40 people in late 2019 after it lost 85% of its business and has since failed to make a comeback due to continued financial turmoil. Ten workers will be affected by the upcoming closure.
