## Notice to Growers Employing Farm Laborers or Using Farm Labor Contractors to Recruit or Supply Farm Workers

Laborers on your farm must be covered by Workers' Compensation insurance and a Disability and Paid Family Leave insurance policy, whether or not such workers were recruited or supplied by a farm labor contractor.

You must obtain and submit the following documentation with your application. You must also keep it available for inspection by Department of Labor or Workers' Compensation Board investigators.

- 1. If you are liable for Workers' Compensation and/or Disability and Paid Family Leave insurance, you must get a completed C-105.2 form proving Workers' Compensation Insurance coverage and a completed DB-120.1 form proving Disability and Paid Family Leave Insurance coverage. Get these completed forms from **your insurance company**. Both forms must be provided to this office.
- 2. If you are **not** liable for Workers' Compensation and/or Disability and Paid Family Leave insurance, provide a completed *Certificate of Exemption*, Form CE-200, to this office. You can get this form online at www.wcb.ny.gov. On the home page, click on "WC/DB Exemptions" then click on "Request for WC/DB Exemption." You may contact the Workers' Compensation Board at (518) 402-8330 for help getting the CE-200.
