Count Question Resolution (CQR)

The CQR operation gives tribal, state and local governmental units the opportunity to request that the Census Bureau review their boundaries and/or housing counts to identify errors that may have occurred while processing their 2020 Census counts.

Special Census Program

A basic enumeration of population, housing units, group quarters and transitory locations at the request and <u>expense</u> of the requesting governmental unit.

- Not a recount of the 2020 Census
- New enumeration that corresponds to the reference date of the new count
- Results incorporated into the next series of annual population estimates that the production schedule allows
- Conducted at the request and expense of requesting government
- Began accepting requesting for cost estimates Match 31, 2023


Boundary and Annexation Survey

All activity legal government's annually Almost 40,000 GU's

- January 1 to May 31 each year
 - March 1st, updates reflected in ACS and Population estimates
 - May 31st, updates reflected in the next years BAS materials
- AIA's are not part of any higher level government submission

- · Select design enhancements recommendations.

Finalize Plans, Conduct Tests

- · Develop detailed plans for each operation.
- · Test new design features as needed.

Implement Plan

- · Finalize census content.
- · Execute the operational plan.

- · Issue Federal Register Notice; 90-day comment period: August 17 - November 15, 2022.
- · Post a prerecorded 2030 Census Research Webinar.
- · Engage the community to encourage feedback.
