Topic 1 – Calculating Tax Savings, 9:00 AM - The Board will hear testimony to determine whether prospective, future tax savings on publicly subsidized projects should be included in total tax savings when calculating whether a project is covered by Labor Law § 224-a.

If future tax savings are to be considered, to determine the rate at which tax savings should be calculated, i.e., whether to factor in anticipated tax increases, inflation, depreciation over time, or other considerations, as well as to determine the length of time projected into the future over which projected tax savings will be included in the total tax savings attributed to the project.
