

2017 YEAR-END SUMMARY

OUTREACH



The Division of Immigrant Policies & Affairs (DIPA) has participated in 206 outreach events and reached 9,301 individuals.

ANTI-HUMAN TRAFFICKING



DIPA participated in 34 anti-trafficking task force meetings and participated in investigations of 37 potential victims. A total of 21 requests for U-visa received and 5 U-visa certifications were issued. A total of 14 requests for T-visa received and 7 T-visa certifications were issued.

HOTLINE CALLS



DIPA received a total of 513 calls to the Hotline and assisted each individual with his or her concern. Seven cases referred to the Division of Labor Standards resulted in \$78,877.62 recovered on behalf of workers.

AGRICULTURE LABOR PROGRAM (AgLP)



AgLP Staff conducted 1,155 Field Activities. Of the 7,711 workers contacted, 3,861 were identified as MSFWs. There were 1,015 Apparent Violations. Of those, 664 Apparent Violations were resolved. The AgLP assisted in the recovery of \$60,574.93 in monies owed to 51 workers.

FOREIGN LABOR CERTIFICATION UNIT (FLCU)



The FLCU received and processed 410 H-2A orders requesting 7,066 workers and 658 H-2B job orders requesting 6,478 workers for businesses in New York.
