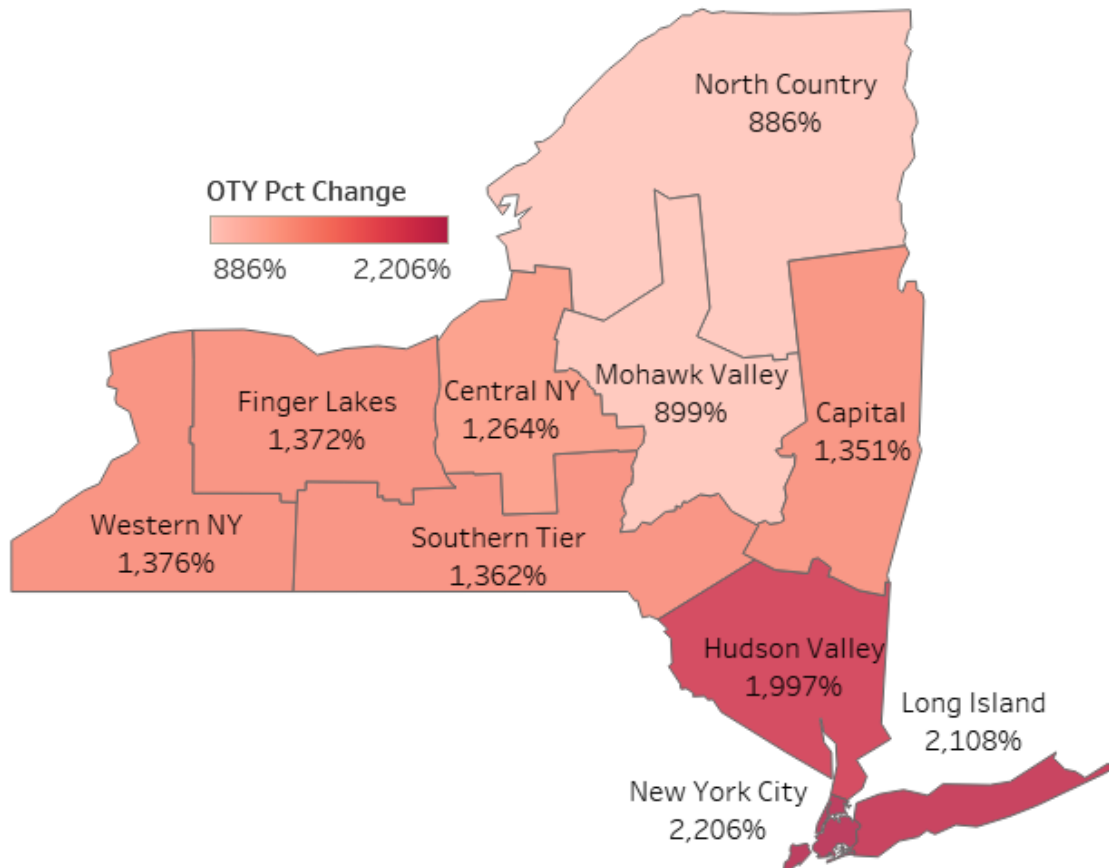


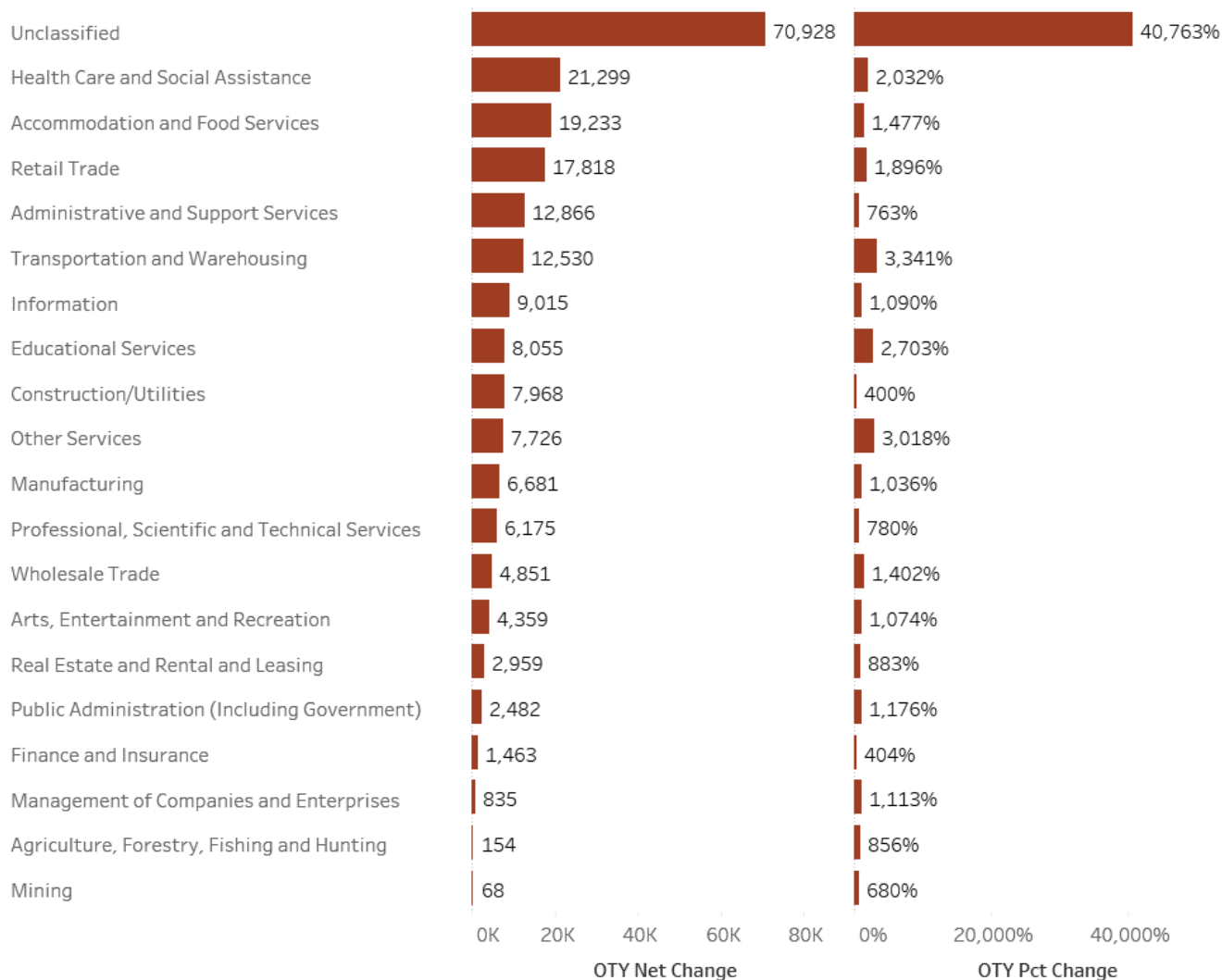
Initial Claims Data

Over-the-Year Percent Change in Initial Claims by Region
Week Ending 5/16/2020



- For the week ending May 16, 2020, initial claims for Unemployment Insurance increased over the past year by 1,798% (including out-of-state residents) in New York State. Initial claims for UI increased by a minimum of 886% in each of New York’s 10 labor market regions.
- Labor market regions with the most rapid over-the-year percentage increase in initial claims included: New York City (+2,206%), Long Island (+2,108%), Hudson Valley (+1,997%), Western NY (+1,376%) and Finger Lakes (+1,372%). At the same time, initial claims for out-of-state residents grew by 1,112%.
- On a net basis, regions with the largest over-the-year increase in initial claims included: New York City (+111,802), Long Island (+27,410), Hudson Valley (+19,550), Western NY (+12,524) and Finger Lakes (+10,182). Initial claims for out-of-state residents grew by 11,319 during this timeframe.

- For the week ending May 16, 2020, all statewide industries experienced an increase in initial claims for Unemployment Insurance over the past year.
- Statewide industries in New York with the most rapid over-the-year percentage increase in initial claims included: Transportation and Warehousing (+3,341%), Other Services (+3,018%), Educational Services (+2,703%), Health Care and Social Assistance (+2,032%) and Retail Trade (+1,896%).

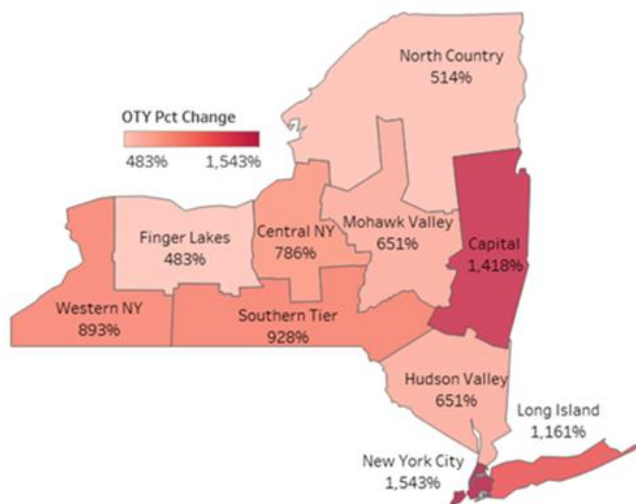

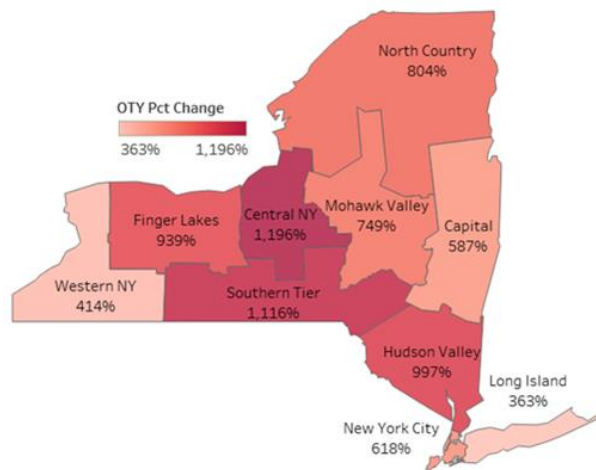
- Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) is a new Federal program that was created as part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. PUA provides financial assistance for individuals who are unable to work due to the COVID-19 pandemic but do not qualify for traditional unemployment insurance (UI).
- Not all PUA claims are included in the count of UI initial claims. Those PUA claimants who applied for UI, were denied traditional UI benefits, and were later approved for PUA are included in the initial claims number. Beginning in mid-April, the State’s application process was modified so that PUA claimants no longer were required to be denied UI benefits before being determined eligible for PUA. In these instances, the PUA claims are not included in the count of UI initial claims.

Over-the-Year Percent Change in Initial Claims by Region

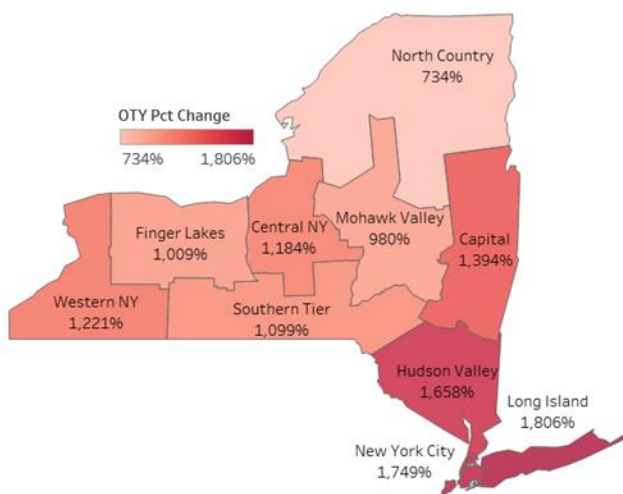

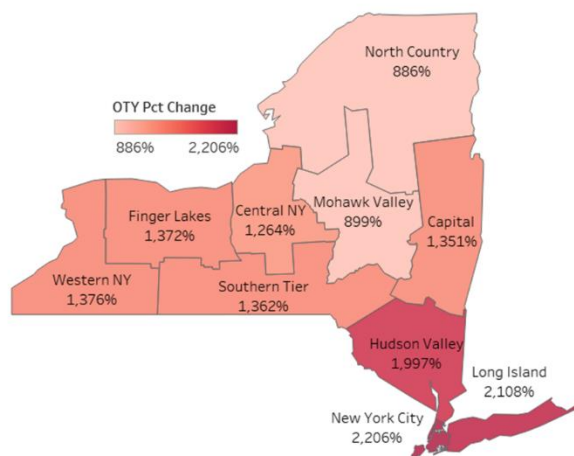
Week Ending 5/2/2020

Glossary

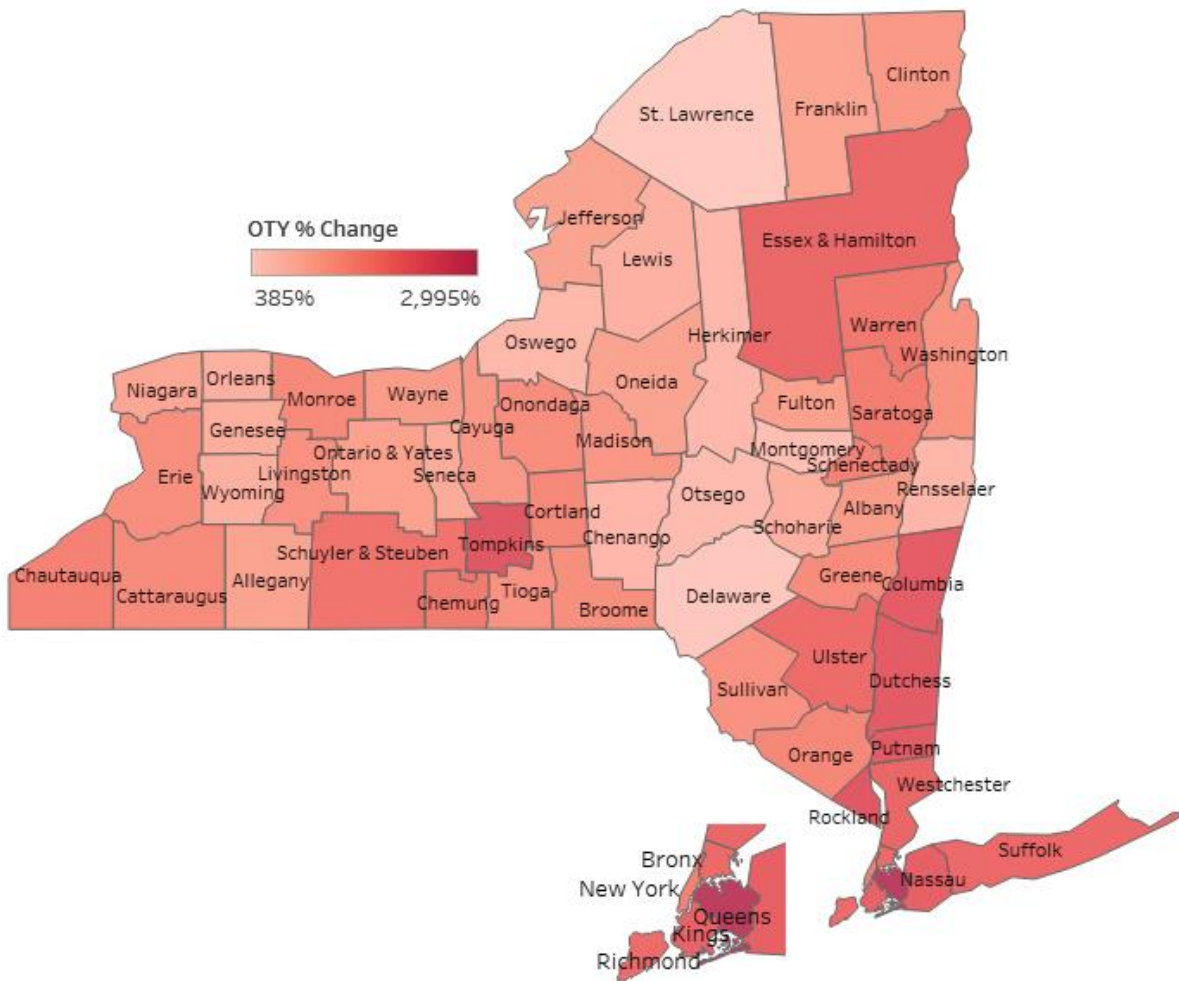
Initial Claim – This category includes both new and additional claims, both of which signify a new spell of unemployment.

New Claim - The first initial claim filed to request a determination of entitlement to and eligibility for compensation.

Additional Claim - A subsequent claim filed during an existing benefit year due to new period of unemployment. Someone who files a new claim and collects benefits, finds another job but is laid off again within the same year would be considered an additional claim.

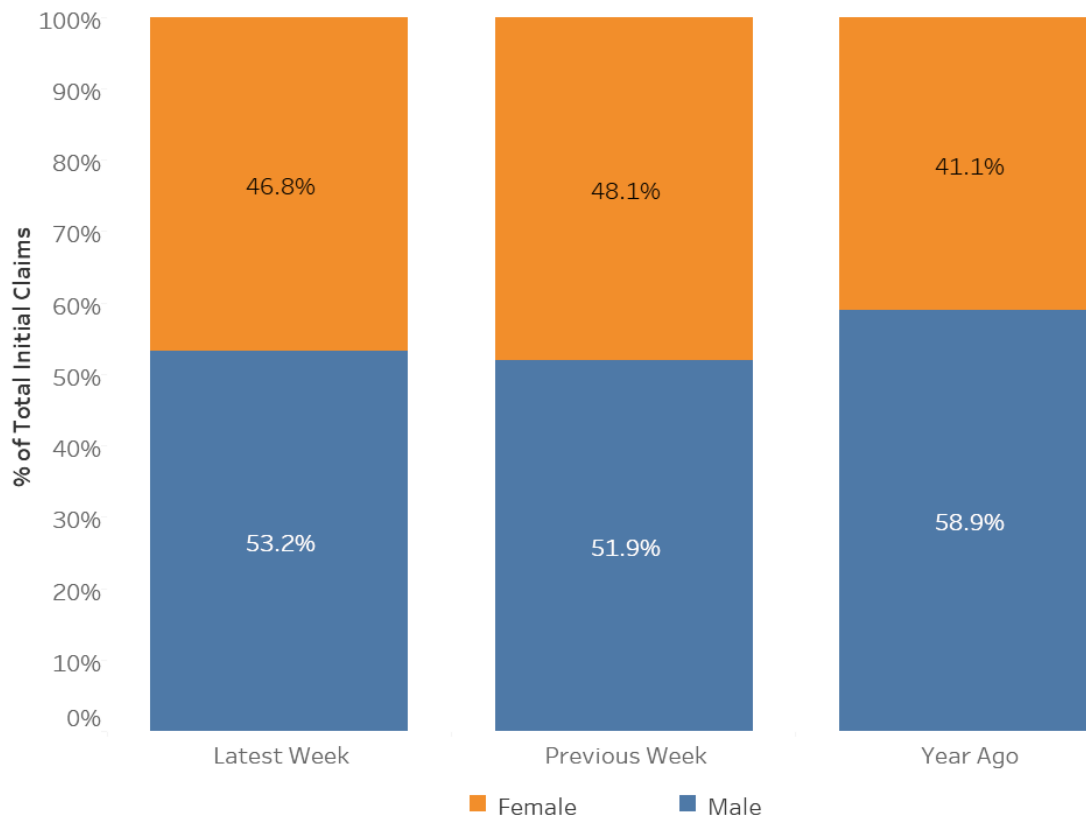

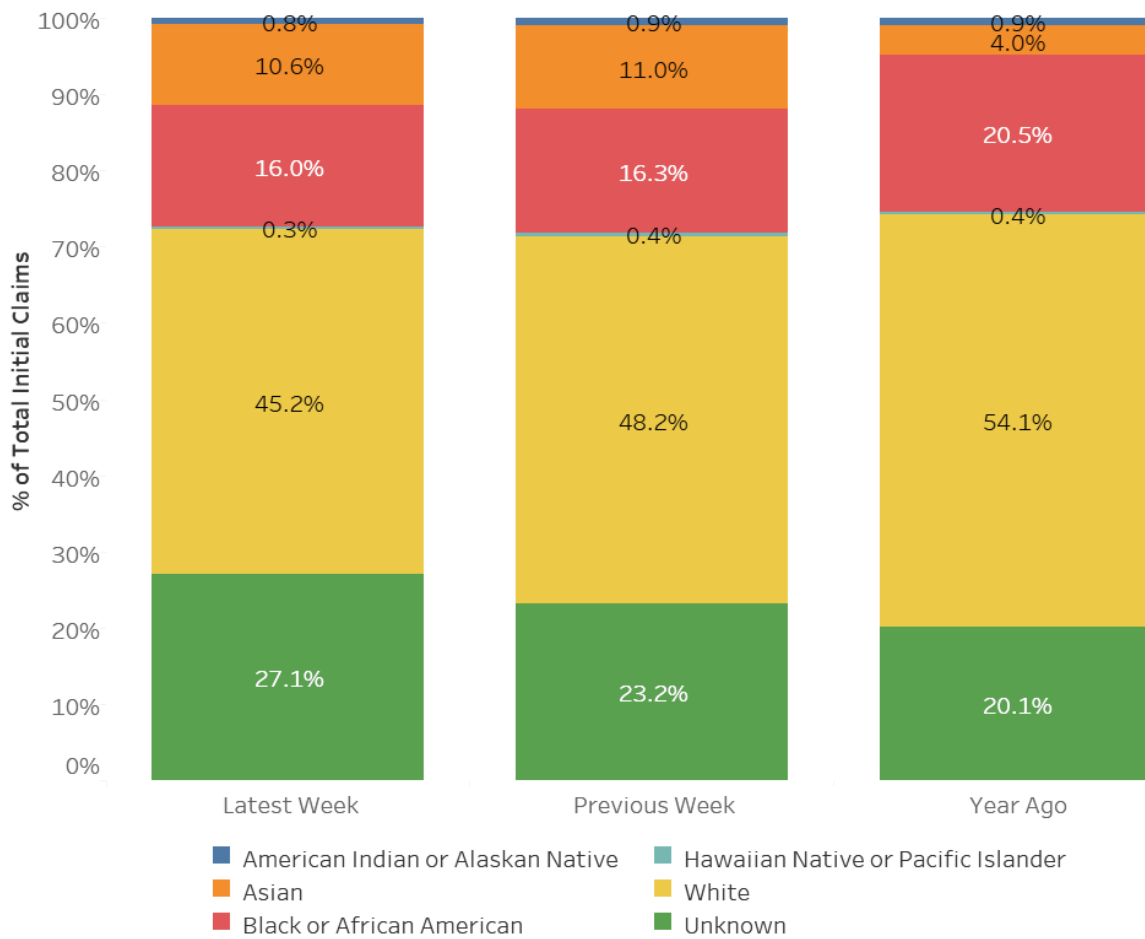

New York State, Week Ending 5/16/2020



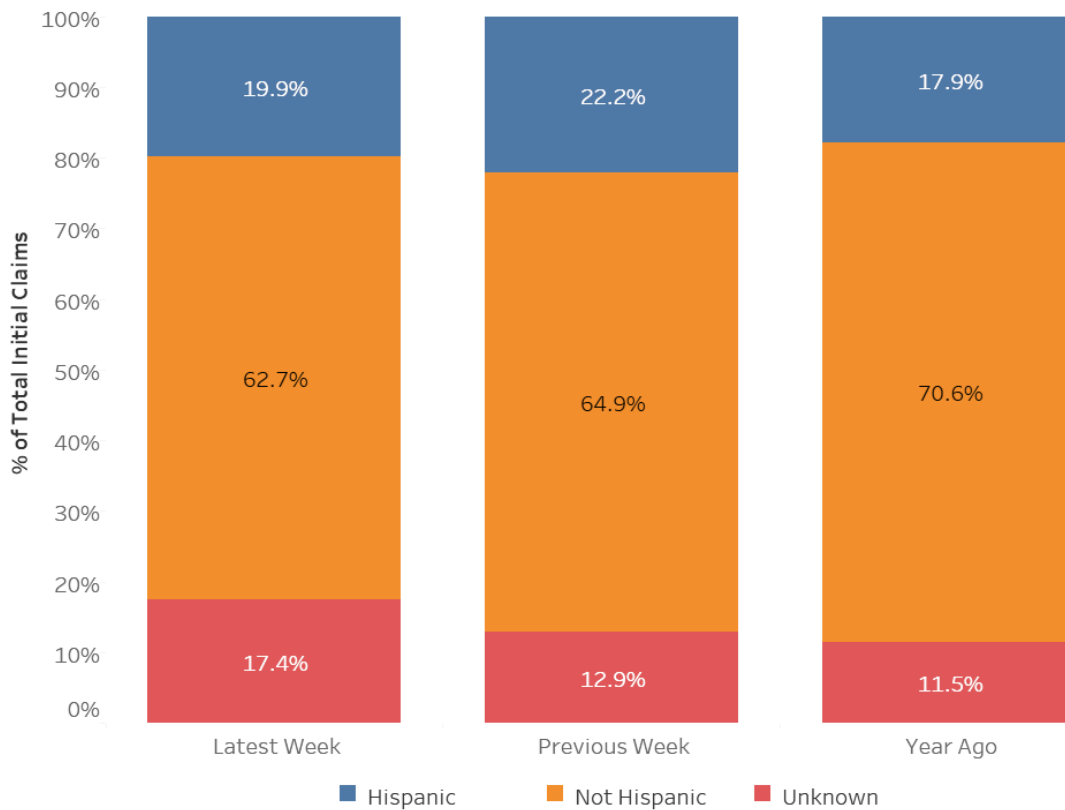

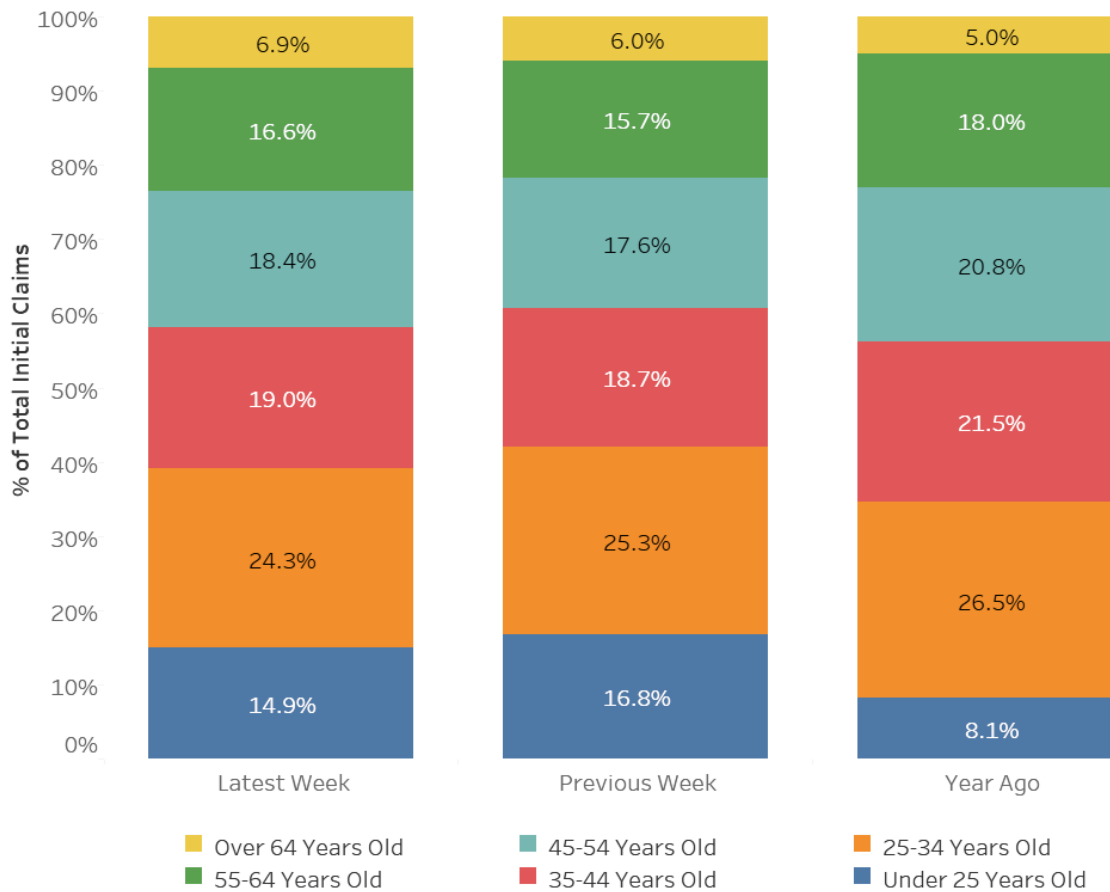
