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## INTRODUCTION

The Current Population Survey is a sample-based, household survey conducted monthly by the U.S. Bureau of the Census for the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS). Although the number of housing units in the sample has varied over the years, about 3,100 New York housing units are included in the survey each month. These housing units yield about 2,300 households that are interviewed; not all households in the sample answer all survey questions.

In the following tables, approximate confidence intervals are calculated at the 90% level, which gives an indication of the degree of precision involved in the parameter estimate. The confidence interval indicates how often -- in this case, 90 out of 100 cases -- you will find a similarly obtained interval that does indeed contain the true value of the unknown population parameter within its limits.

For example, New York State's unemployment rate in 2006 was estimated at 4.4 percent, with a 90% confidence interval of 4.1-4.7 percent (see Table 1). Thus, if repeated samples were drawn from the same population and a confidence interval constructed around each sample estimate, then the true value based on a complete census of the population would be contained within these ranges 90% of the time. The confidence intervals for 1999 through the current year are produced by BLS, and will be included in these tables for the current year once they are available. Confidence intervals in these tables prior to 1999 are estimated. Confidence intervals for Table 13 and Table 14 were estimated as they are not provided by BLS.

The numbers presented in the tables are rounded to the nearest thousand. Rates are based on unrounded data. Data are not released for estimates of less than 5,000 individuals or rate estimates with a base of less than 35,000. These suppressed estimates are noted by "n/a". Items may not add to totals due to rounding. These data are based on public use files and may differ slightly from published Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) estimates of CPS data. There are two sources of differences in the estimates: the public use files have confidentiality protections added and the public use files are not revised with new population controls. In addition, these tables contain estimates not available on the BLS site and are unofficial estimates. CPS data also differ from Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) data which are based on a statistical model that uses CPS labor force data as an input.

It is important to note that there are a number of series breaks in the data presented in the following tables.<sup>1</sup> These breaks occur due to a number of different reasons including: changes in survey methodology, adjustment for population undercounts, and/or questionnaire redesign. Thus, care should be exercised when using these tables as a time series.

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<sup>1</sup> The specific dates for the breaks in series include: December 1983/January 1984; March 1988/April 1988; October 1989/November 1989; December 1989/January 1990; and, December 1993/January 1994.
